

CALL FOR ICR GRANT(s)

ICOM GENERAL CONFERENCE, KYOTO, JAPAN 2019

To encourage ICOM colleagues to participate in ICR's Kyoto programme of activities, we announce two Travel Grants. The maximum amount of each subvention is 1500 euros for ICR members who wish to take part in the ICR Annual Conference, Kyoto Japan. One grant will be given to a young member (35 years or under).

The grants will provide assistance for airfare (economy) and/or accommodation.

ICR Grant Application process:

Applicants must follow the criteria:

 Be a member of the ICR in good standing (include ICOM number with letter of application)
Write an essay of at least 150 words (300 words max.) explaining why you want to attend the Annual Meeting; explain other funding sources received.

Paper must be given in English.

3. Agree to deliver a paper or presentation in English during the ICR conference programme related to the ICR theme. Your proposal should include:

An abstract of no more than 350 words, together with a 75-word biography and up to 5 key words. Abstracts should include the following:

- Title
- Name and institution of the author (ICOM number)
- E-mail address

• Any special technical requirements (for example a Mac or PC for accompanying images, video)

4. Suggest a height of expected grant (without 330 € conference fee)

5. Write a report on the ICR conference experience for the ICR Newsletter and report to colleagues at home about the experience with a copy to the ICR

To apply, send a CV with a cover letter explaining your cause. Applications should be submitted to <u>orit@israntique.org.il</u> before the 15th of March 2019.

Successful candidate(s) will be expected to give a presentation on the theme of the Annual Meeting (please see the Call for papers 2018).
